
Little Maggie

This song uses the F chord. Refresh your memory about how to form the F major chord a few times before working on the tune. Notice that you do not have to use the 4th string during the F chord so you don't have to use the ring finger at all.



This song illustrates a shorthand form of writing out tablature which uses two alternate **endings** called the first ending and the second ending. On the first pass through play ending marked "1." and on the second time skip over and use ending marked "2."

Notice that some of the measures use mixtures of quarter notes and eighth notes. Practice each measure alone before you tackle the entire tune.
